Keith Gardner owns his own consulting business and serves as the president of eMRI. He has been consulting and training in the area of organizational performance for more than 20 years. He has personally worked with

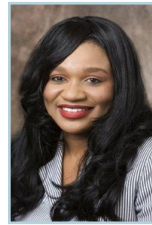
hundreds of clients from various industries in 17 countries around the world.

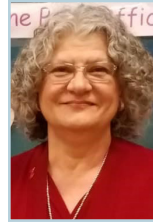
