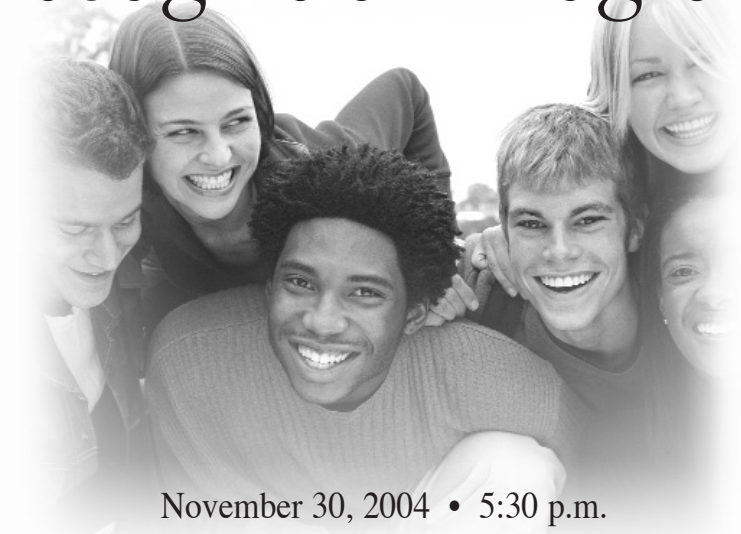

The now "National Technical Honor Society" has its national headquarters on the campus of Blue Ridge Community College in Flat Rock, NC, and today serves over 1,800 schools and colleges throughout the US and overseas.
