

COCA-COLA TWO-YEAR SCHOLARS PROGRAM

Open to Eligible MTC Students

In keeping with Coca-Cola's long-standing commitment to post-secondary education, this program recognizes students attending two-year degree granting institutions for their unique contributions to community service and academic excellence.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Student must be enrolled at a two year, degree granting institution.
- Student must be a U.S. citizens or permanent resident.
- Student must demonstrate academic success (with a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale).
- Student must have engaged in community service within the previous 12 months as validated by their college nominator or is employed full or part-time.
- Student must be planning to enroll in at least two courses during the upcoming fall term at a two-year institution.
- Student can not be a child or grandchild of Coca-Cola employees.

DEADLINE TO APPLY: MONDAY MAY 5, 2008

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Applications are available through the Office of Student Life – ASC 126 or BSC 101. Return completed applications to Student Life ASC 126 or BSC 101 by Monday, May 5, 2008.

SELECTION PROCEDURES:

An ad hoc committee will be formed to review applications and submit one nominee to the Coca-Cola Two Year Scholars Program Review Committee.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITION:

An independent committee of educators, appointed by the Coca-Cola Foundation, will review the nominations and select 400 winners, each to receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Winners will be notified by August 1, 2008. Disbursements will be made in September to the recipient's college for credit to his/her account.
