

To MTC Community:

During the past week, we have had a number of vehicle break-ins on the Airport and Beltline campuses where items were taken out of the vehicles. There are three specific precautions that can be taken to prevent these types of thefts. You can remember these precautions easily by using the acronym **V.I.P.**

1. **V**isibility. When parking on campus, make every effort to select a parking space that can be seen from a distance.
2. **I**nspect the area. Look around before leaving the vehicle. If you see a vehicle or any suspicious activity, get the license number and a description of the occupant(s) or suspicious individuals and notify Campus Security immediately at 738-7850.
3. **P**ersonal items. Do not leave personal items inside your vehicle. If items must be left in the vehicle, place them in the trunk or other areas out of sight.

The MTC security team wants to do everything it can to make our campuses safe for students, employees and visitors. We hope you will help us by remembering the **V.I.P.** precautions when parking and exiting your vehicles.
