

Respiratory Care Program Admissions Checklist 2010 Midlands Technical College

The purpose of Merit Respiratory Care admissions is to allow students who have been accepted into the Respiratory Care Program to apply for special consideration for priority admission with an earlier start date. Points are awarded on pre-set, published criteria. Students are admitted based on the number of available slots.

If a student earned a grade of D, F, or **WF** in any RES course, he/she is not eligible for Merit Admissions.

Instructions for completing the Merit Respiratory Care Program Admissions Checklist:

1. Applicants must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for Merit Respiratory Care Admissions:
 - Acceptable admission criteria:
 - Successful completion of the interview process and acceptance through the regular admissions process to the Respiratory Care Program.
2. Applicants **must** include a copy of their MTC college transcripts and/or MTC transfer transcripts. MTC college transcripts can be accessed by going to **MTC Online** and clicking on “MTC Transcript” and transfer grades can be accessed by clicking on “Transfer Transcript Summary.”

It is the applicant’s responsibility to ensure that all coursework from previous colleges has been evaluated and posted on the transfer transcript summary **before** applying for Merit Admissions. (**Allow three weeks processing time**).
3. Applicants **with prior health care work experience** may contact Mr. Eddie Jackson (822-3437) for additional information that may be considered and included with this application.

Important Information Regarding the Merit Respiratory Care Admissions Checklist:

1. Completed Merit Checklists must be submitted to the Student Center (Airport Campus), Room 215, c/o Kim Lander or mailed to Midlands Technical College, P.O. Box 2408, Columbia, SC 29202, and Attn: Admissions / Airport Campus. Completed checklists and required documentation must be **received by June 15, 2010** no later than 4:30 pm. Checklists postmarked on or before May 31, 2010, will not be processed if they arrive after June 15, 2010 at 4:30 pm. Letters indicating acceptance or non-acceptance for Merit Admissions will be mailed by June 15, 2010.

Incomplete Merit Checklists will not be processed.
