



**E. Ronald Andrews Environmental Scholarship - \$2000**

The South Carolina Palmetto Chapter of the Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA) Scholarship Committee is seeking qualified candidates for the E. Ronald Andrews Environmental Scholarship. SWANA is a statewide professional association of individuals and organizations that are involved in resource conservation and solid waste management. SWANA is an international and national association.

Students enrolled at least half-time in Solid Waste Management, Environmental Engineering, Public Health, Environmental Studies, or other environmental related programs at accredited baccalaureate and graduate level educational institutions are eligible to apply. Students must be attending school or working in South Carolina or must be a South Carolina high school graduate. Preference may be given to SWANA members and their immediate families (children, spouse, grandchildren, siblings, parents). **This year the SC Palmetto Chapter of SWANA is offering one scholarship up to \$2000.** The scholarship will be presented at a SC Palmetto Chapter of SWANA event to be scheduled.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, the Scholarship Committee Chair must receive applications **no later than August 31, 2009**. Students are only eligible to be awarded the scholarship one time. Completed applications should be mailed to the attention of Russ Hightower at the address listed below.

Applications must include:

1. A letter of application that includes a brief description of the applicant's career goals in the field of environmental and/or public health (Note: preference will be given to those applicants whose career goals and field of study relates to solid waste management);
2. A copy of the student's undergraduate transcript and/or their current graduate transcript, and their graduate school study plan;
3. A letter of recommendation from their advisor, professor or another representative in the environmental field familiar with their studies; and
4. Documentation supporting the student's declared major.
