Acceptable documents may include copies of your I-20s, visa, and transcripts, or a letter

from the school stating the dates you attended there as a fulltime student. If OPT is authorized, the copy of the I-20 must reflect this. If you were on an H-1 visa, you must provide documentation of your arrival/start date and a copy of the approved "Notice of Action", an official company letter showing your authorized dates of employment, or a W2 form showing you worked for the company that sponsored your visa.
