# MIDLANDS TECHNICAL COLLEGE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT DATA



Midlands Technical College's (MTC) mission is to provide "accessible, affordable, quality education that prepares a diverse student population to succeed in the job market, to transfer to four-year colleges and universities, and to achieve their professional and personal goals. The college equitably provides higher education opportunities that stimulate the local economy by generating a world-class workforce and enhancing the social vitality of the community."

In conjunction with the South Carolina Technical College System (SCTCS) and Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), MTC has identified eight areas to measure student achievement. These student achievement criteria are appropriate to open admission 2-year institutions, provide data to evaluate MTC's progress toward achieving its mission, and serve as system level performance measures that determine the appropriation of new state dollars. These student achievement areas were identified from MTC's internal critical success factors and measurement standards established by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education (CHE). Achievement data include:

## **RACE AND GENDER PARITY**

MTC's goal is to align enrollment with the population demographics from the three counties that make up the college's service area. Thresholds have been established to allow students to define their race and gender individually and not an attempt to define race and gender biologically, anthropologically, or genetically. The success criteria for race is that the student body at MTC will be within ten percent parity of the race composition of the MTC service area. The success criteria for gender is that the student body at MTC will be within 10 percent parity of the gender composition of the MTC service area. Since the Fall of 2014, the percentage of undergraduate students by race and gender has fallen within our established thresholds. See Table 1 and 2.

## **GRADUATE PLACEMENT RATES**

Graduate placement rates reflect the success of graduates with respect to employment or continuing their education. MTC reports job placement rates of graduates of all degree, diploma and certificate programs annually to SCTCS. The MTC graduate placement rate criteria (80%) and threshold (+/5%) is aligned with SCTCS Program Evaluation Report formulas and requirements. Over the past five years, MTC has successfully met or exceeded the +/-5% success criteria threshold.

### **FALL TO SPRING PERSISTENCE RATES**

Persistence rates are commonly used student progress measures for both two-year and four-year institutions. As a means of assessing system-wide persistence rates, SCTCS has adopted the National Community College Benchmark Project (NCCBP) definition as a means to calculate credit students' next-term persistence rates. MTC has established the Fall to Spring persistence rate criteria of 71% and threshold of +/-5% to align with SCTCS formulas and requirements. Since 2014, MTC has met the criteria and is within the established threshold.

## **LICENSURE EXAMINATION PASS RATES**

The licensure examination pass rates are used by all programs whose graduates are required to successfully pass a licensure examination. MTC has established a licensure examination pass rate criteria of 80%, and threshold of +/-5% on first-time licensure exam test takers across all programs to align with SCTCS formulas and requirement.

Since 2014 - 2015, MTC's licensure examination pass rate has averaged above 85% across all programs. MTC faculty and program coordinators continue to closely monitor the licensure examination pass rates to ensure students are receiving the instruction necessary to pass their respective examinations. Faculty use the licensure examination results to assist in understanding the strengths and weaknesses of the curriculum and make adjustments where needed.

### **STUDENT SUCCESS RATE**

The student success rate is a cohort-based measurement of graduation, transfer to another post-secondary institution, or continuing enrollment after three years from first-time enrollment. The cohort includes all first-time freshman: those who have never attended a college who enrolled in a degree, diploma, or certificate program in a given fall semester. The student success rate criteria of 90% and threshold range (30% to 45%) are aligned with CHE formulas and requirements. The MTC student success rate percentage should fall between the CHE established success rates of 30% to 45%. Since Fall 2012, MTC has fallen within or exceeded the established CHE thresholds. The college continues to focus on increasing student graduation rates through the most recent 2018-2021 MTC Strategic Plan, developing an initiative to increase the graduation rates of first-time, full-time students.

### **GRADUATE PRODUCTION RATE**

The graduate production rate is a measure that reflects MTC's fulfillment of its workforce development mission. The rate includes all awards for degrees, diplomas, and certificates and removes time bound and demographic restrictions. It measures the unduplicated headcount of graduates and expresses it as a percentage or rate. MTC has established a graduate production success criteria rate of greater than or equal to 20% to align with SCTCS formulas and requirements. Since 2014, MTC has successfully met the established criteria.

### **COURSE COMPLETION PERCENTAGE**

The course completion percentage calculates the percentage of MTC students who successfully complete their courses. Successful completion is defined as receiving a grade A, B, C, or S (satisfactory). MTC has defined unsuccessful completion as receiving grades of D, F, W (withdrawal), WF (withdrawal/failure), U (Unsatisfactory), NC, or I (Incomplete). MTC has established the course completion success criteria as 70% and threshold of +- 5% to align with internal critical success factors. Since 2014, MTC has successfully met the established criteria.

## STUDENT COMPLETION INDICATOR RATE

In Spring 2018, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) asked member institutions to select a key student completion indicator that most accurately represents MTC's student completion pattern. MTC selected the National Student Clearinghouse (NSCH) total 6-year completion rate. The NSCH total 6-year completion rate is made up of first-time degree-seeking students, of any age, who began their postsecondary education in Fall 2010, Fall 2011, or Fall 2012. Each cohort is followed through May 31st of the sixth academic year and highlights the six-year student outcome, including degree and certificate completion and continuing enrollment (persistence).

MTC has established the key student completion indicator rate of +/-5% of the NSCH overall 6-year completion rate for two-year public institutions. Since Fall 2010, the MTC key student completion indicator has fallen within the college's established thresholds.
