

# NURSING FORGIVENESS FAQs



## WHAT IS NURSING FORGIVENESS?

The Nursing Forgiveness Policy allows select students the opportunity to return to the Nursing program and retake a series of nursing and/or biology courses. Students must adhere to strict guidelines determined by the Nursing Department.

## HOW CAN I APPLY FOR THE FORGIVENESS PROGRAM?

Students must attend a mandatory Nursing Forgiveness overview session and complete the required documentation. Typically, these mandatory sessions are held the third Monday of select months. Please contact the Admissions Office for specific dates and times. Students will be notified via postal mail of their “forgiveness” status.

## DO I NEED TO PREREGISTER FOR A NURSING FORGIVENESS OVERVIEW SESSION?

Yes, preregistration is strongly encouraged. Preregistering allows the Nursing and Admissions Departments an opportunity to review your academic record and provide advice before attending the session. For more information, please contact the Admissions Office.

## HOW WILL I BE QUALIFIED TO BE READMITTED TO THE NURSING PROGRAM?

You must first be approved for Nursing Forgiveness, then you must meet the *current* Nursing admissions criteria.

## WILL I BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR MERIT NURSING ADMISSIONS?

## IF I HAVE NOT BEEN GRANTED NURSING FORGIVENESS, CAN I BE ADDED TO THE QUALIFIED LIST?

No. The Nursing Forgiveness process must be completed first.

## WILL I BE REQUIRED TO PAY THE \$100 DEPOSIT AT THE NURSING FORGIVENESS OVERVIEW SESSION?

No. The \$100 deposit is due after attending the Nursing Orientation session, and it is non-refundable.

## IF I HAVE BEEN AWAY FROM MTC FOR MORE THAN THREE (3) SEMESTERS, SHOULD I REAPPLY TO MTC?

Students should attend the Nursing Forgiveness overview session before reapplying.
